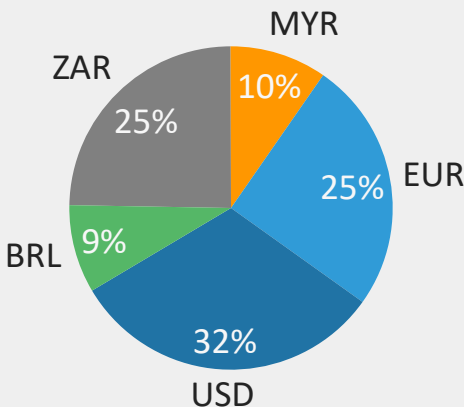

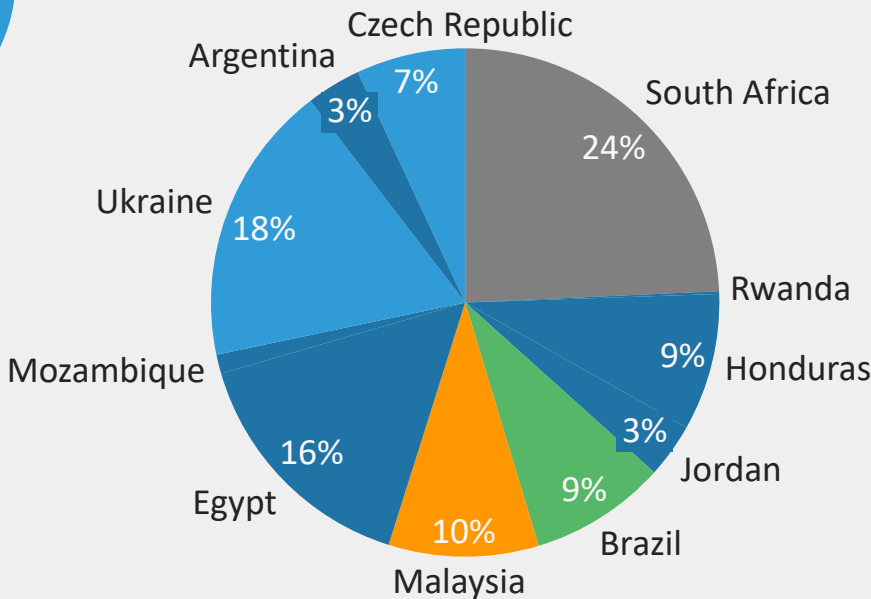

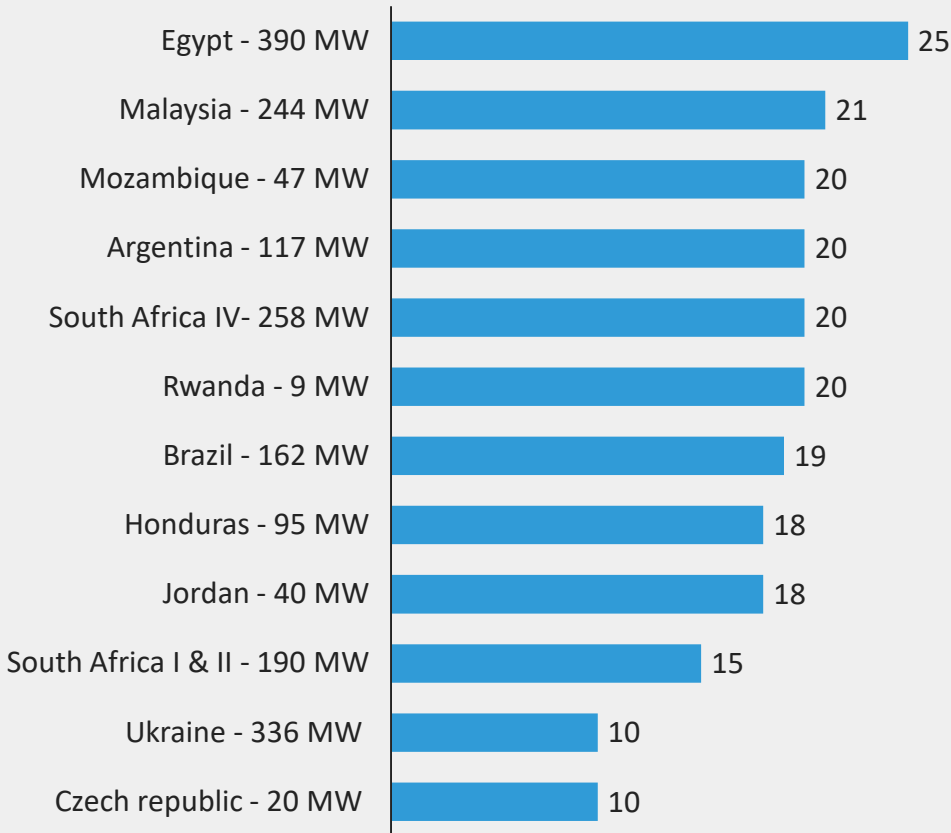
Portfolio currency split*:



Portfolio country split*:

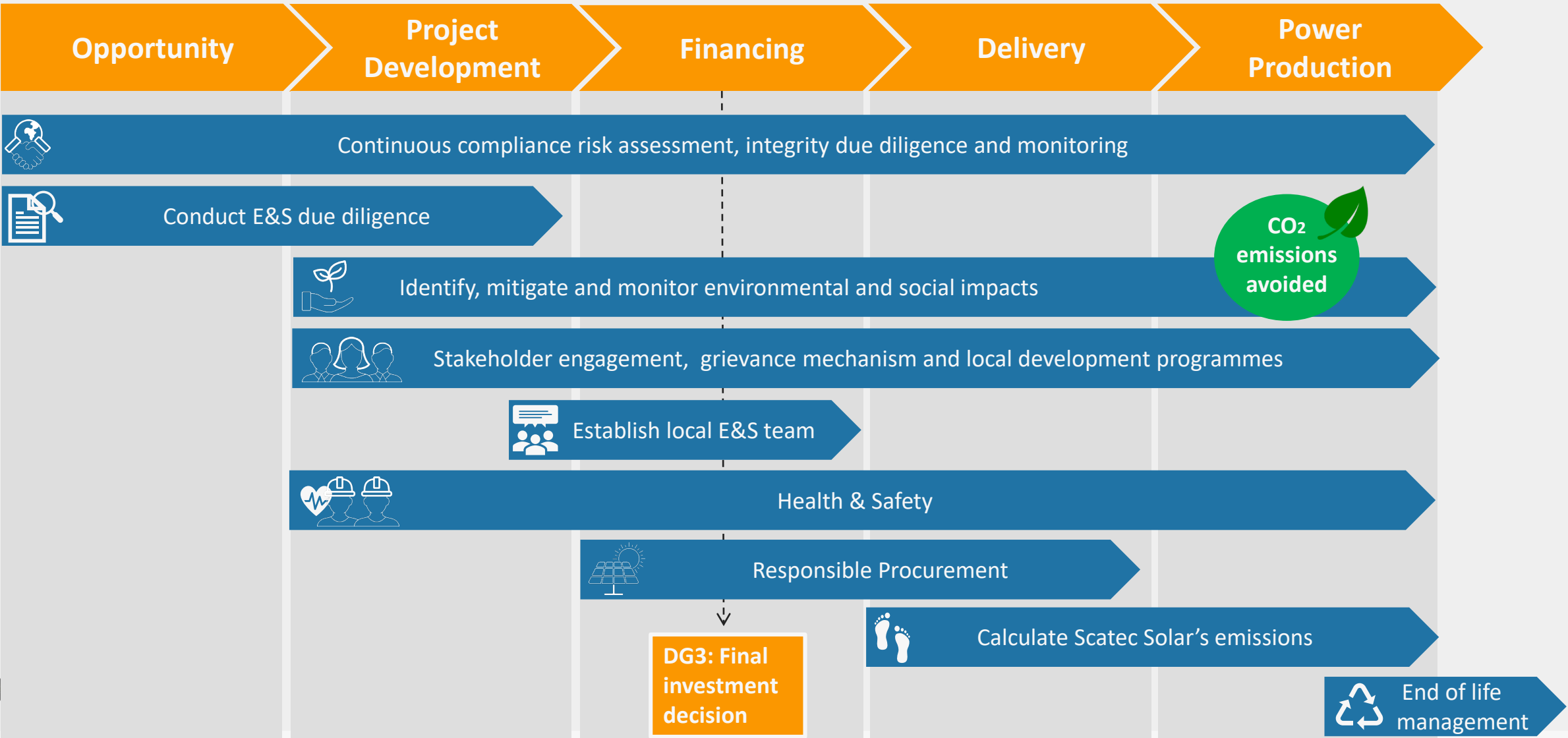


20 years average remaining PPA tenor:

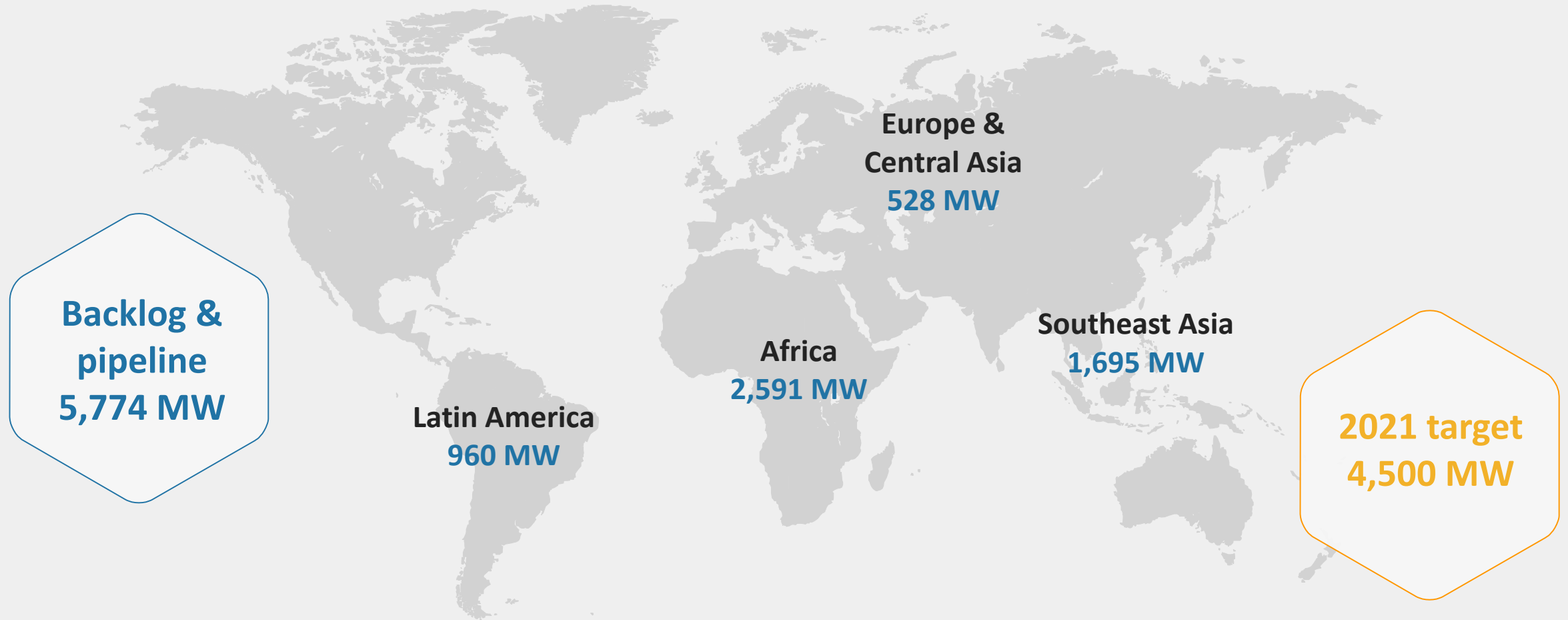
